Milwaukee Film Request for Proposal: Concessions Stand

1. Project Overview -

MKE Film is in need of consultant services to assist with the programming, budgeting and redesign of the existing concessions area at the Historic Oriental Theater in Milwaukee Wisconsin. This work is anticipated to be included in the second of four phases of the theater's renovation/restoration project. Phase two design will commence in February 2019. Construction will begin in May/June 2019 and will be completed no later than September 15, 2019. The theater will be operational during renovations.

2. Organizational Background

Milwaukee Film is a nonprofit organization established in July of 2008. The organization's vision is to create a film festival in Milwaukee that is locally beloved, internationally acclaimed, and a true forum for our diverse community; to offer year-round education programs for all ages, teaching the role and power of film in the modern media landscape; and to provide strategic support to filmmakers and projects. Programs targeted at residents of all ages in the Greater Milwaukee Area include the Milwaukee Film Festival, Education Screenings for local school groups, Reel Talks, and year-round filmmaker services through the Milwaukee Filmmaker Alliance (funding, forums, and networking events).

Milwaukee Film's 24 full-time staff members work year-round to plan, program, and market the annual film festival and rely on over 100 seasonal staff, 3 interns, and 300 volunteers to execute the festival. Recent major accomplishments include a total attendance of 78,510 at the 2018 Milwaukee Film Festival.

In 2017, Milwaukee Film signed a 31-year lease to operate the historic, three-screen, 1600-seat Oriental Theatre in Milwaukee. Since August of 2018, the Oriental has showcased first-run, repertory and educational programs, in addition to the Milwaukee Film Festival.

3. Scope and budget

MKE Film is looking for a firm to provide design services for the demolition and construction of a new concessions area. Services may be design or full turn key solution. Scope is inclusive of the following::

- Assistance in finalizing the menu. MKE Film has a list of menu items and needs assistance in final determination of the menu
- Layout of concessions to increase efficiency both behind the counter once an order is placed as well as
 efficiencies in how customers are cued up to place an order. It should be noted, for some performances,
 the concessions counter/area is where movie tickets are purchased
- Systems/software review and recommendation; examination and recommendation of the current POS system. The Oriental theater has a POS system that interfaces with (or integrates?) the various MKE Film memberships. it is sometimes cumbersome and can increase transaction time. Team members have found work arounds to make the system operate more efficiently, but is this the best method for MKE Film to use?
- Examine and provide recommendation on primary (concessions area) and secondary (dry storage)
 equipment and storage for product including ice, beer, wine and similar
- Digital menu board selection and placement
- The construction of a second concessions area in the balcony is part of a future phase of work, but it should be factored in with the planning and design of the first floor concessions area. Preliminary layout and cost estimating for the concessions area in the balcony should be included in this scope of work
- Layout, design, equipment and material selection, utilities included but not limited to water, electric, HVAC, low voltage, and similar, case work, lighting, all accessories necessary for a fully operational concessions area
- provide estimated cost of new concessions area including design, demolition of existing concessions area and construction of new concessions area

- This building is a landmark and has historic characteristics that MKE Film will want reflected in the
 materials and finishes in the concessions area. Close coordination with the architect and MKE Film will be
 necessary to obtain the desired end product
- Understanding and compliance with local codes and requirements including Health Department regulations is required
- Recommendation of construction timeline and sequencing of work to minimize disruption of the sales and operation of the theater
- Be available to answer questions during construction
- participate in final walk through to inspect the concessions area and create a punchlist of items that require corrective action
- participate in commissioning of equipment and owner training

4. Schedule

Milwaukee Film is looking to make a final decision regarding the selection of the concession stand vendor by **January 31st, 2019**. This will give Milwaukee Film time to incorporate the concession stand design into other existing construction timelines.
